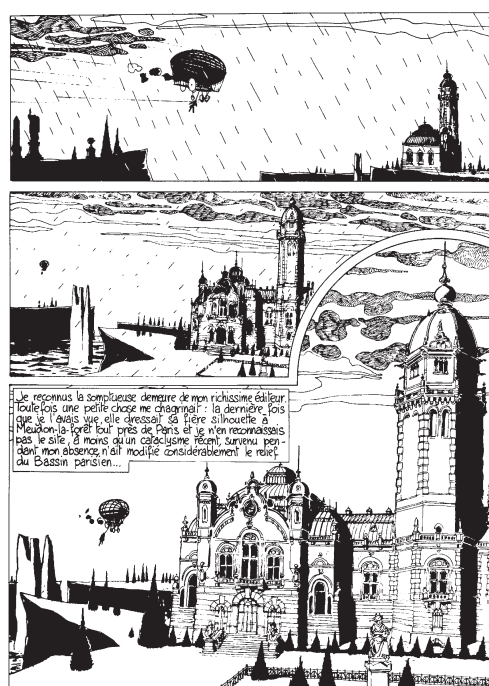


Don't miss this reprint of two hard-hitting, outspoken stories by one of contemporary comics' major creators.

Tardi opted to pair the piece with *The National Razor*, a screed against capital punishment written around the same time in his life.

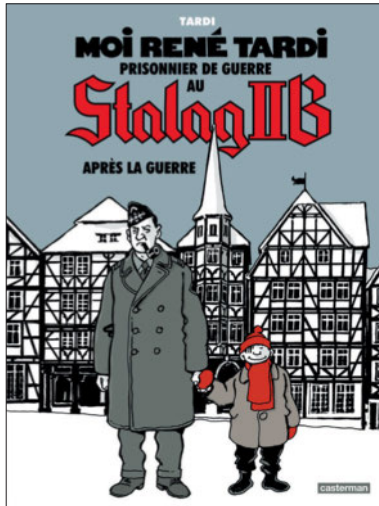
